Notice is hereby given that the City of Whitesboro and the Whitesboro Economic Development Corporation will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, June 29, 2009 at 5:30PM at the Whitesboro City Hall, 111 W. Main, Whitesboro, Texas to review the Texas Capital Fund – Downtown Revitalization Project grant application prior to submittal to the Texas Department of Agriculture. Citizens are encouraged to participate.

The City will submit application using a combination of TCF grant funds and local resources for Texas Capital Fund Downtown Revitalization Project funding of \$150,000.00 with a match of \$50,000.00 by the Whitesboro Economic Development Corporation for walkway replacement and enhancement in the 100 Block of East Main, Whitesboro including the North and South sides of Main Street and including the relocation of public utilities. The application deadline is July 7, 2009 and the application is available for public review at the Whitesboro City Hall beginning June 29, 2009 during regular business hours. A Public Hearing is required as part of the project application submittal process.

Citizens unable to attend this hearing may submit their comments to the Economic Development Director and/or the City Secretary, City of Whitesboro, at City Hall (111 W.
