

Feature Artist Rob Jordan

- *Entries should be **picked up** on Sunday after the show's closing or on Mon. 8 am to 5 pm or Tues. 8 to 7:30. Any work left will be disposed of after Friday, March 15.
- *Where possible, work will be displayed according to the following: children 5-12 years, teens 13-19 years, and adults 20 & older.
